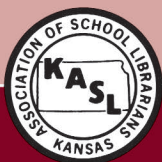

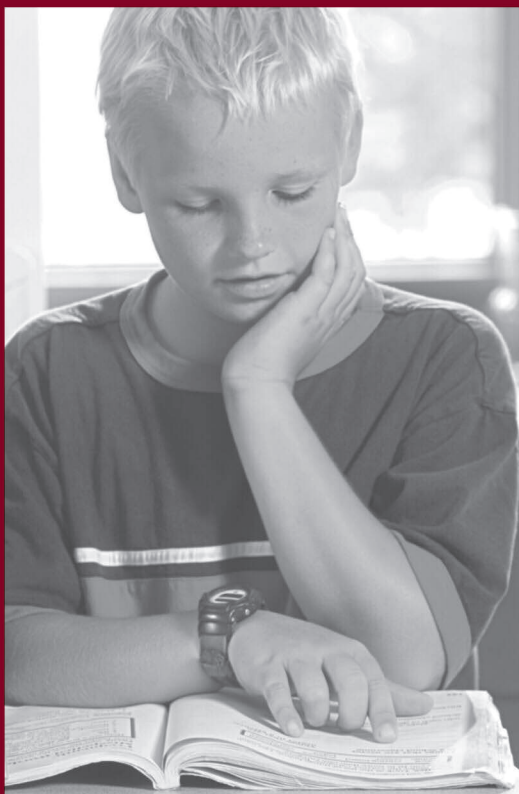


## WHO IS KASL?

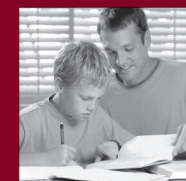
