

Kansas Students Achieve Because of Great School Libraries

Powerful Partnerships: Your School Librarian and YOU!

School library media centers and licensed library media specialists make a difference in your students' performance¹.

There is often confusion surrounding the difference between school libraries and public libraries. This confusion leads, at times, to the assumption that both of these entities perform the same service and therefore can be easily combined or substituted, one for the other. Kansas has all types of libraries. Each type has a distinct mission, collection focus, user group, and array of services. Each type of library collects resources and provides services especially designed for their specific clientele and has library staff with specialized training for their type of library. These libraries cooperate with each other to offer the broad array of library services that Kansans enjoy.

- Public Libraries, serve the needs of the general public.
- School Libraries, serve the needs of the K-12 students and teachers.
- Academic Libraries, serve the needs of higher education.
- Special libraries serve the needs of businesses, governmental agencies, institutions and organizations.

Because there are, for the most part, school and public libraries serving every Kansas community, and because they cooperate to provide services, it is sometimes assumed that one or the other could close, with little impact to that community. This is not true. The table opposite illustrates the particular missions, primary services, and librarian roles of school and public libraries.

Visit your school library and talk to your teacher librarian - find out what goes on there and how the teacher librarian facilitates learning!
